CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By completing an entry form you acknowledge receipt and agree to observe these conditions and all subsequent amendments and additions. Failure to observe these conditions may lead to cancellation of any entry.

1. For the purposes of this document Entrant/s means Vehicle Captain/s. Crew or Crew Members means all other people participating in TasBash Teams.
2. Variety - the Children's Charity Tent 78 Tasmania Inc ABN 22 532 462 253 (hereafter referred to as Variety Tasmania) shall select the Entrants who are to join the TasBash. The criteria for selection will be as determined by the Variety Tasmania Office from time to time. Variety Tasmania shall not be required to give any reason for the non-selection of an Entrant and no correspondence will be entered into.
3. Any vehicle entered in the TasBash must be licensed, insured and roadworthy as prescribed by State Laws.
4. There is no age restriction on the vehicle that can participate in TasBash. You can bring any car you like just have a team theme.
5. Motorcycles, buses, coaches, caravans, skateboards and motorised wheelbarrows are not permitted to enter the TasBash. Special conditions apply to support vehicles.
6. High Performance modifications need to be cleared with Variety Tasmania Office and TasBash Director prior to accepting entry.
7. All vehicles must, at all times during the event, display the event sponsors' stickers supplied by the Variety Tasmania Office.
8. All Entrants must pay an entry fee. Such entry fee must be paid in accordance with the instructions on the Entry Form. All payments must be paid to Variety - the Children's Charity Tent 78 Tasmania Inc ABN 22 532 462 253 in accordance with the payment schedule.
9. In addition to the entry fee, Entrants must fund raise a minimum contribution, including donations, as detailed in Clause 9. Teams must strive to raise as much funds as possible, beyond the minimum schedule. All funds raised will be added to the Team's tally up until the 15th October 2019, which will determine fundraising awards. Further contributions can be made after this date and during the TasBash which will be attributed to the following years tally for that team.
10. The minimum fundraising requirement if participating for the full five days is \$2,700; \$2,200 for four days; \$1,600 for three days; and \$900 for one – two days.
11. All money raised is due and payable in accordance with the dates and instructions cited on the Entry Form. Both the entry fee and contributions in excess of the entry fee are non-refundable.
12. All Entrants and Crew Members must each pay provisions fee due and payable in accordance with the dates and instructions cited on the Participant Provisions Form.
13. Variety Tasmania does not provide any taxation advice and makes no representations concerning the income tax deductibility or any entitlement to an input tax credit for any fees or contributions made to Variety Tasmania. The Entrant should seek and obtain his or her own independent accounting or legal advice concerning all such matters.
14. All Entrants and anyone taking part in the TasBash, in any way, must complete and submit to the Variety Tasmania Office **ALL** documentation advised by Variety Tasmania (which includes, but is not limited to, the Entry Form, Participant Indemnity, Vehicle Indemnity Form, Crew Form, Personal Medical Information Form, Code of Conduct, Rules and Regulations, Participation Provisions Payment Form, Social Media Policy, Police Check Form (valid for two years), Evidence of Working with Children Registration (valid for three years). Entrants must coordinate with Crew Members to ensure their completion of required documentation relating to the TasBash and submit this to Variety Tasmania by the dates listed on the Document Checklist. In the event that an Entrant completes and signs a document (or documents) on behalf of another crew member or crew members that is (or are) required by Variety Tasmania, the Entrant attests that he or she has the consent of the crew member or crew members to do so.
15. At all times all Entrants must abide by the rules of the road as prescribed by State laws and statutes.
16. Entrants must at all times observe all rules, regulations and vehicle specifications as issued by the Variety Tasmania Office. All Entrants must comply with the TasBash Code of Conduct.
17. An Entrant must not carry out any fundraising activity which may bring the Variety Tasmania name into disrepute or cause Variety Tasmania to breach any statutory requirements.
18. Entrants are not to operate bank accounts for the purpose of fundraising using the name of the Variety, Variety Tasmania, Bash, TasBash, Bash Car, TasBash Car or any combination thereof.
19. An Entrant shall not use the Variety Tasmania name, or represent that it or any fundraising event has any connection with Variety Tasmania without the prior written consent of Variety Tasmania.
20. The Entrant indemnifies Variety Tasmania against any penalty or liability Variety Tasmania may incur as a consequence of any conduct of the Entrant.



21. Variety Tasmania reserves the right to conduct random breath and drug testing of drivers.

22. As outlined in the Variety Tasmania Soft Credit Policy, soft credits will be attributed to your fundraising total to qualify for bronze, silver, gold or platinum. Soft credits will, however, not be counted towards the Highest Fundraiser Award.

Variety Tasmania's decisions and rulings are final and binding on all Applications, Entrants and Crew Members.

Further conditions of entry may be drawn up by the organisers and will be printed in the regular newsletters issued by Variety Tasmania.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Variety the Children's Charity Tent 78 Tasmania Inc ABN 22 532 462 253 (hereafter referred to as Variety Tasmania) requires all motoring event Entrants, Crew Members, Officials and Staff Members to abide by the following:

1. As this is a Variety Tasmania event, you are required to abide accordingly and in line with the terms of Variety Tasmania's code of conduct.
2. **LEADERSHIP:**
All arising matters, incidents, accidents, medical conditions, conflict or any other matters that could be perceived of significance must be reported promptly and professionally to the Bash Director in the first instance. The Variety Tasmania CEO must also be kept informed on all such matters.
3. **RANDOM BREATH TESTS**
Participants agree to wear a Designated Driver's badge, or similar ID, while driving, which will be supplied to each team. The Designated Driver's badge signifies and obligates the wearer to be alcohol and drug free at all times whilst driving a TasBash vehicle. Random breath tests may occur from Tasmanian Police at any time and the designated driver must be at 0% Blood Alcohol Content (BAC).
4. **CHILDREN AND SCHOOLS**
Children are extremely excited about the TasBash coming to nominated schools. While having a good time with the kids, we must take extra care as they often cannot see the potential dangers.
 - Be careful driving near children and never throw things from your vehicle as they may swarm your vehicle and get hurt. Pull up and get out of your vehicle before giving presents to the kids.
 - No smoking or alcohol within 150metres of school gates.
 - For your own peace of mind and that of Variety Tasmania, never find yourself alone with a child. Please ensure children remain under the supervision of those responsible for them. While schools have strict policies regarding this issue, once again, many children would be unaware of potential dangers. We certainly do not want to find ourselves being falsely accused of any wrong doing.
 - Lollies have always been a favourite for the TasBashers to hand out to children, however this is now considered inappropriate by many schools (obesity, allergies, disabilities which make swallowing difficult etc). Variety Tasmania has found it necessary to make the TasBash sweet-free, for children at least! In lieu of sweets, can we suggest age-appropriate items such as bubble blowers, soft toys and children's books etc.
5. **MEDIA**
All media enquiries, interviews or requests are to be approved by either the CEO of Variety Tasmania or Chairman.
6. **DISQUALIFICATION**
Entrants may be expelled from the TasBash in the following circumstances:
 - Bringing the name of Variety Tasmania into disrepute.
 - Actions that compromise safety of the event or another person
 - Drunk and disorderly behaviour or being under the influence of illicit drugs.
 - Offensive behaviour.



- Assault or threatening behaviour towards a fellow competitor or the general public.
 - Tampering with other people's vehicles or possessions with malicious intent.
 - Altering road or directional signs.
 - Vandalism.
-
- Refusing to obey reasonable directions of Officials or Organisers.
 - Not maintaining a duty of care as considered by a Reasonable Person.
 - Entering into any discussion, correspondence or social media activity that could be construed as derogatory or libellous towards Variety Tasmania, Entrants, Officials, Staff and the public.
7. Any person ejected from the TasBash will be automatically excluded from any future Variety Tasmania events (this includes events conducted by other States).
8. **COSTS**
Variety Tasmania will not be responsible for costs incurred by early expulsion from the TasBash.
9. **MEETINGS**
At the start of the TasBash event, all participants are to attend the Start Briefing meeting prior to departure. At the conclusion of each day (usually prior to dinner) participants must also attend similar meetings. These meetings advise the entrants of vital information about the route, fun stops and Variety Tasmania presentations along the way.
10. **DISPUTE RESOLUTION**
Bash Director and CEO will resolve disputes of any nature and hear evidence from all parties involved in the dispute and any witnesses in order to arrive at a decision.
11. **BEHAVIOUR**
Warnings, that may lead to expulsion, will be given for behaviour or incidents that are deemed inappropriate.
12. **VEHICLE PASSENGERS**
Officials are required to know the whereabouts of all entrants. If you plan to ride in another TasBash vehicle, please inform an Official immediately. You are forbidden from allowing any non-participant to travel in your TasBash vehicle unless authorised by Event Management.
13. **ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**
Further conditions of entry may be drawn up for individual States and Territories by the Event Management and distributed in writing to all Event Participants wherever practicable, however during the period of the Event, the Event Management may specify further conditions verbally where it is impractical to provide notice of the same in writing to the Participants. Conditions of entry are subject to change without notice.
14. **INSURANCE AND INDEMNITY COVER**
It is the responsibilities of each participant to have the appropriate insurance and indemnity cover. Variety Tasmania takes no responsibility for the Participant's failure to do so. All participants must also read the Participant Indemnity section contained within this document, tick the Participant Indemnity box detailed on Participation Document cover sheet attached and sign this cover sheet to signify agreement to be bound by the terms cited within the Participant Indemnity section.



THE DECISION OF THE EVENT MANAGEMENT REGARDING ANY MATTER IS FINAL. A breach of the Code of Conduct as defined in this document could damage the integrity of Variety Tasmania and Variety Australia and put at risk the future of the Event and the Charity.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. In the interest of safety, insurance and event management, the requests and directions of all people designated by Variety Tasmania to be 'Bash Director' or 'Officials' will be observed at all times.
2. The TasBash route is that set by Variety Tasmania with the approval of road owners. If these roads are affected by adverse weather conditions, Officials will liaise with local councils, Forestry Tasmania, Sustainable Timber Tasmania, owners/managers and any other appropriate bodies to determine an alternative route. Any participant who disregards the Bash Director's instructions to abort the original route will be ejected from the TasBash.
3. If any participant needs to leave TasBash route an Official (first preference is the Bash Director) is to be notified by either radio or phone.
4. If you cause any damage to any property en-route you are required to report any such incident immediately to the Bash Director. The owner of the property will need to be compensated for the damage caused. The participant must endeavour to resolve this matter and any compensation required promptly and professionally and ensure that no further reputational damage is directed at Variety Tasmania throughout the whole process. On a case-by-case basis, Variety Tasmania may, in good faith, resume the role of a mediator to assist in promptly resolving any dispute that arises, however Variety Tasmania must not be held responsible or made to suffer any liability as a result of this intervention.
5. **DO NOT** under any circumstances change signs or add instructions to signs as there could be disastrous results.
6. Litter is not to be thrown from any TasBash vehicle. Carry all litter with you and dispose of it appropriately at the next designated spot.
7. The TasBash is not exempt from normal road and traffic rules. Any infringements such as speed limits, blood alcohol limits, travelling with an open container of alcohol may be prosecuted by police.
8. TasBashers must not interfere with other people's vehicles or personal property.
9. Flour bombs and other messy projectiles are banned (this includes food products).
10. Firearms and fireworks are strictly banned from TasBash.
11. Entrants are prohibited from bringing their own support vehicles on the TasBash event, unless authorised by Event Management.
12. Always ask permission to overtake another vehicle. The overtaking vehicle must signal by radio communication to overtake and wait for clearance from the other vehicle before performing the manoeuvre. A driver about to be overtaken must allow the following vehicle to overtake when safe by moving to the side of the road and, if necessary, slowing or stopping.

In consideration of Variety - the Children's Charity Tent 78 Tasmanian Inc ABN 22 532 462 253 permitting the Participant to take part in the Variety Federal Group TasBash, the Participant will comply with the following:

DEFINITIONS IN THIS AGREEMENT. In this Agreement:

"Bash" means 2019 Variety Federal Group TasBash.

"Variety the Children's Charity Tent 78 Tasmania Inc ABN 22 532 462 253" means Variety Tasmania and each of its officers, members, employees, agents and independent contractors and any volunteer assisting it in connection with the Bash.

"Bash Event Manager" means the person nominated by Variety Tasmania to be in charge of the overall event.

"Bash Director" means that person nominated by Variety Tasmania to be in charge of the Road Event.

"Bash Rules" means rules set by Variety Tasmania.

"Claim or Demand" means any claim, demand, action, proceeding, judgment, order, award damage or costs of any nature.

"Participant" includes the legal or personal representatives of the Participant.

"Entrant's Support Crew" means and includes (but is not limited to) each person travelling with an entrant in his/her vehicle and each person assisting the Participant in any way including (but not limited to) a mechanic, a member of a mobile workshop team or supply team or any person acting in that capacity and their legal or personal representatives.

"Landowner" means and includes the owner, lessee or occupier of any land and any employee, agent or independent contractor of any such person.

"Vehicle" means the vehicle used by the Participant in the Bash.

1. The Bash is potentially hazardous to those taking part and the Participant does so at his/her own risk.
2. The Participant acknowledges that, although Variety Tasmania will take all care in connection with the Bash and the carrying out of the Bash, Variety Tasmania accepts no responsibility for any Claim or Demand.
3. The Participant will comply with all laws and legal requirements and with all directions of the Bash Director regarding safety including, but not limited to, requiring Participants to undergo alcohol breath tests. The Bash Director may require any Participant to cease participation in the Bash if the Participant has a blood alcohol reading in excess of that permitted by law. The Bash Director may also require any Participant to cease participation in the Bash if it is, in his or her opinion in the interests of safety.
4. This Agreement will not be affected or altered except by Variety Tasmania. The Participant acknowledges that it has not relied on any representations made by, or on behalf of, Variety Tasmania.
5. The Participant indemnifies and holds harmless and will keep indemnified and held harmless:-Variety Tasmania from all Claims or Demands, whether known or unknown, by any person against Variety Tasmania arising from or related to, either directly or indirectly, the Bash or the carrying out of the Bash; and each Landowner from all Claims or Demands, whether known or unknown, by any person against the Landowner arising from or related to, either directly or indirectly, the Bash or the carrying out of the Bash.
6. The Participant will not advance, institute, prosecute, cause, procure, finance or support directly or indirectly, the advancement institution or prosecution of any proceeding of whatsoever nature, including (without limitation) any examination, inquiry or investigation, against Variety Tasmania or any Landowner jointly or severally which relates to or touches upon the Bash or the carrying out of the Bash.



7. The Participant releases and forever discharges Variety Tasmania and each Landowner from all Claims or Demands, whether known or unknown arising out of or relating to the Bash or the carrying out of the Bash.
8. This Agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with the law of the State of Incorporation of Variety Tasmania.
9. The Participant must comply with the Bash Rules. The Bash Director may require the Participant to cease participation in the Bash if the Participant fails to comply with any of the Bash Rules.
10. The Participant must at all times hold a current Driver's License and produce same when requested by Event Management.
11. The Participant permits the use of photographic images and footage to be used by Variety Tasmania for internal and external promotional materials.
12. Further conditions of entry may be drawn up by the organiser and will be printed in regular Newsletters issued from the Variety Tasmania Office and the Participant must comply with these.
13. The decision of the Bash Director regarding any matter is final.

SOCIAL MEDIA GUIDELINES

Variety Tasmania event participants are encouraged to communicate about their involvement in these events, however we strongly urge anyone who participates in online commentary to understand and to follow these simple but important guidelines. The overall goal of these guidelines is to ensure any participation in these activities is conducted in a respectful, relevant way that protects the brand and reputation of Variety Tasmania and does not jeopardise its future fundraising activities.

The following guidelines relate to involvement with social media platforms, including but not limited to Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, You Tube, online blogs and My Space.

When using social media platforms in relation to Variety Tasmania events, you should consider the following:

1. Social media cannot be used for any communication that is discriminatory, harassing, derogatory, defamatory, obscene, sexually explicit or pornographic, or for any purpose that is illegal or that is contrary to Variety Tasmania's policies or business interests.
2. Be aware of Variety Tasmania's Vision and Values and ensure any social media interactions are consistent with these values.
3. Be responsible for what you write and be authentic. All statements must be true and not misleading and all claims must be able to be substantiated. Never represent yourself or Variety Tasmania in a false or misleading way.
4. As Variety Tasmania is a children's charity, it is important not to post images that illustrate inappropriate alcohol consumption or photos that portray Variety Tasmania and/or its events in a negative light. i.e. Pictures of someone that may have overindulged with Variety branding.



5. Be transparent. If you are writing about Variety Tasmania, use your real name, identify any official involvement with Variety Tasmania, and be clear about your role, where relevant.
6. Never participate in social media when the topic being discussed may be considered a crisis or accident situation. Even anonymous comments may be traced back to you or your IP address. Refer any social media activity around crisis topics to the CEO immediately i.e. posting pictures of an accident on the TasBash.
7. Exercise good judgment and post only meaningful and respectful comments. Avoid spam and do not make remarks that may be deemed offensive.
8. Use common sense and common courtesy. Publish or report on only those issues and conversations that are relevant to you and always respect the privacy of others. i.e. Do not post personal information of other participants or staff. Do not upload images of children without obtaining written permission to do so from their parents or guardians. (Image release forms are available from Variety Tasmania).
9. Consider your audience. Remember that your readers can come from anywhere, and may include current or future customers or stakeholders of Variety Tasmania. i.e. Social media includes child subscribers.
10. Be smart about protecting yourself and Variety Tasmania. Remember what you publish is widely accessible and will be around for a long time, so consider the content carefully.

BASH BREAKDOWNS

Flat tyres, fuel problems and electrical faults cause the most common breakdowns on the TasBash.

The idea of the TasBash is that you should be able to do some of the basic things yourself (such as changing a flat tyre), however, don't be too distressed if you can't. Where we are able to help is with the more complicated and/or larger jobs. As you may have to wait a while until OV2 comes along, (we will be there as soon as we can but please remember there is only one OV2 and occasionally a big job rears its head) it helps us if some of the initial preparation is done while you are waiting, such as jacking the vehicle up or getting the spares out etc.

IN THE ENGINE BAY

As the going is likely to be dusty on the TasBash, it is a good idea to get a good quality air cleaner element along with a couple of spares. They should be changed regularly on the TasBash. Sand and dust getting into an engine through the air cleaner can do a very rapid job of reboring your engine, and without the necessary larger pistons and rings, can turn your lovely motor into a pile of junk.

The way to avoid fuel problems on the TasBash is to ensure your fuel system is top notch. Fit fuel filters before and after the fuel pump. Take along spare filters.

Cooling systems should be thoroughly checked, radiators cleaned, hoses, thermostats and belts replaced if necessary. Thematic fans should be checked to ensure the correct direction of rotation. Radiator stone guards should be of a material that causes minimal disruption to air flow.

ELECTRICAL PROBLEMS

To reduce the chances of problems it is wise to get your car looked over by an auto electrician. Frayed wiring should be taped up and the generator, alternator and starter checked over.

Take along basic spares such as points, plugs, condenser, even a rotor, coil and distributor cap.

Make sure the battery is very secure and the battery holder is not rusted away.

Take along a spare fan belt and power steering belt if fitted.

TOOL KIT

Nothing too large, an assortment of screwdrivers, shifter, small ring and open end spanners, pliers, side cutters, pocket knife, racer tape, electrical tape, some small and medium size cable ties, a pair of multi-grips, and some insulated wire of the size used in cars.

FIRST AID KIT

The St John Ambulance kit is a good choice with the addition of some aspirin and some Berocca's. Check the Variety Tasmania minimum standard for first aid kits and make sure yours exceeds that spec. A \$10 first aid kit just isn't going to cut it.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT (compulsory)

A safety reflective triangle is required plus a hi-visibility jacket.



WATER

You must carry four litres of water. It can be in one container or in a number of containers.

JACK

A jack is needed together with a jack plate to prevent the jack sinking into soft ground. A piece of solid wood is ideal. Don't forget the wheel brace.

YOUR VEHICLE IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY. We will not be doing vehicle checks prior to the start. However, we reserve the right to check your vehicle at any time. If the Sweeps or Bash Director are in any doubt they can postpone or cancel your start.

REMEMBER TO ROAD TEST YOUR VEHICLE IN ITS FULLY LOADED STATE BEFORE TASBASH!
