Who can enter?

Anyone over 18 years of age with a passion for driving and exploring with a sense of humour, a tolerance for dust and discomfort, plus a real yearning to meet up with friends they haven't met yet.

What does it cost?


You will need a minimum fundraising donation of \$2,000 to enter - this can be via a range of fundraising methods including sponsorship, donations from family and friends, raffles, events and challenges etc. Upon registration, we will set you up with a fundraising page to assist you in your fundraising endeavours. There will also be a small provisions fee to cover some meals and miscellaneous items supplied on the event. Entrants are required to fund their own accommodation, fuel and car related costs.

Accommodation

Entrants must book their own accommodation. There are a range of accommodation styles to suit everyone's tastes and budgets. In some towns accommodation is limited and availability is not guaranteed. A list of suggested accommodation options can be found on the event website.

What type of car do I need?

For the Variety Resurrection Run, you can bring your Bash Car or similar, a 4WD, or any vehicle you are happy to take down an unsealed (gravel or dirt) road or track. To take part, each car must have event signage displayed, carry a first aid kit and have a UHF CB two way radio that can operate on channel 20 (handheld is acceptable but must be 5 - watt). Full list of requirements is available from our website.



1. All vehicles must attend the nominated Checkpoint day and pass all requirements as set by the Regional Motoring Events Manager. 2. A crew must be a minimum of two people and a maximum of 4 people. 3. Crew members must be a minimum of 18 years of age and hold a current driver's licence. 4. All vehicles must carry on the front doors the door panels, front and rear entry numbers and windscreen strips supplied. 5. Everyone taking part in this event in any way must complete an indemnity agreement issued by Variety – the Children's Charity NSW/ACT. 6. All entries in the event must have paid to Variety – the Children's Charity NSW/ACT, either personally or through donations the specified entry donation prior the start of the event. 7. Provision fees and extra merchandise must be paid prior to the start of the event. 8. Everyone attending any part of this event must have a current Working With Childrens Check (WWCC). 9. Must adhere to any reasonable request made by event officials. 10. At all times everyone on the event must abide by the rules of the road as prescribed by State Laws and Statutes.
