

## Jet Trek FAQs

### Why are you now running two Jet Trek events?

Due to the popularity of the Jet Trek, we have decided to run a second event to give everyone the opportunity to get involved. Since inception, the Jet Trek has raised over \$1.45 million so that Aussie kids can have a fair go. An additional Jet Trek event each year enables more men and women to get involved in an iconic event while raising money to help more kids.

### When and where are the two Jet Trek events?

**Sydney to Yamba, 19 - 24 March, 2018** (currently all places are full)

**Airlie Beach to Mission Beach, 3 - 9 June, 2018** (newly launched event but places are limited, so we'd encourage you to register now)

### What is the itinerary?

Day 1 – Airlie Beach – Whitehaven Beach – Airlie Beach  
Day 2 – Airlie Beach to Bowen  
Day 3 – Bowen to Townsville  
Day 4 – Townsville Lay Day  
Day 5 – Townsville to Lucinda  
Day 6 – Lucinda to Mission Beach

### What if I am already registered for the Sydney to Yamba event but I want to switch and do the Airlie Beach to Mission Beach event instead?

### \*I've already booked accommodation for the Sydney event; can I get a refund?

Accommodation is non-refundable, however please speak to our Event Manager, Erin Searles as she may have another trekker looking for accommodation.

### What if I am already registered for the Sydney to Yamba event and I would now like to do the Airlie Beach to Mission Beach event as well?

Fantastic! We encourage you to register now for the Airlie to Mission Beach event, as places will fill fast and are limited. There is also an early bird offer on now with a discounted registration.

**I have raised \$5,000 for the Sydney to Yamba Jet Trek, can I transfer half of this across to the second Jet Trek?**

No, the goal is for each Jet Trek to raise as much as possible so we can help more kids, so we can't transfer funds as per our terms and conditions, however we can give you plenty of tips and support to ensure you exceed your fundraising goal.

**What is the minimum fundraising requirement?**

The minimum fundraising is \$2,500 as with other Jet Trek events, however the average raised by our Trekkers is \$3,600 because of all the support we provide.

**What is the registration fee?**

The registration is \$200 including GST, however we have an early bird offer of \$165 including GST.

**Can I get a discount if I am doing both?**

No, we are not able to offer a discount.

**What will the provisions be for the Airlie Beach to Mission Beach event?**

Provisions will be announced in January, however as a guide we would recommend allowing approximately \$800 per adult.

**What are the fundraising instalment dates for the Whitsundays Jet Trek?**

- \$750 donation/fundraising on or before 15th December, 2017
- \$750 donation/fundraising on or before 9th February, 2017
- \$1,000 donation/fundraising on or before 27th April, 2018
