ROUND 1 SHEET: A vehicle safety inspection Round 1 Sheet report is to be done by your mechanic **prior** to attending the **FREE** Workshop Inspection at the centers listed below. The report that is completed is to be retained by YOU to be given to the Scrutineer at Round 2 and Round 3.

ROUND 2 SHEET: You will be required to present your Round 1 completed sheet. The Round 2 sheet is to be completed by the appointed Scrutineer when your vehicle is checked at one of the locations listed below. This sheet is then to be stapled to your completed Round 1 sheet, **kept by you** and presented at Round 3 (Final Scrutineering) in Mackay before the Bash begins.
