

CHILD PROTECTION AND

CONFIDENTIALITY POLICIES

CHILD PROTECTION

This policy guides staff,

volunteers, supporters and sponsors on how to behave when working with children. Although staff, supporters and volunteers at Variety work in various capacities with children, this code of conduct applies to all who work face—to—face, online and remote interaction with children. Variety Tasmania is committed to the safety and wellbeing of all children who are involved in our work. We support the rights of children, as well as those of staff and partners, and encourage their active participation in the building and maintaining of a safe environment for children.

Variety Tasmania and all those who work with us will act at all times in the best interests of children, and will do all that we can to ensure their safety.

This policy forms part of the formal induction process for all employees and volunteers of our organisation.

All children who participate in our work are involved in reviewing, promoting and enforcing this policy, so they are familiar and comfortable with the procedures for raising complaints. This policy is reviewed on an annual basis.

Confidentiality

Variety Tasmania respects the privacy and rights to confidentiality of all people involved in our work. It is everyone's responsibility to maintain confidentiality on issues experienced by young people and to report those only in an appropriate manner to relevant staff. Personal information will only be shared if it's relevant to the participation of a child involved with our organisation, or where it may place staff or another person at risk.

CODE OF CONDUCT

DO NOT

- •Spend time alone with a young person.
- •Engage in rough physical games, hold, kiss, cuddle or touch children or young people in an inappropriate and / or culturally insensitive way.
- •Use sexualised or inappropriate language, even as a joke.
- •Practice favouritism when building relationships with young people
- •Consume alcohol, non—prescription drugs or illicit drugs when acting on behalf of Variety.
- •Offer children any food or drink (due to allergies).

- •Conduct yourself in a manner consistent with your position as a staff member, partner, or volunteer of Variety Tasmania, and as a role model to young people.
- •Our number one priority is the safety and well being of children. This is to be remembered and adhered to in all activities.
- Treat all people with respect and be open to and accepting of diversity and difference in people's backgrounds, work style and personal preferences.
- Raise all concerns, issues or problems with a Variety staff member.
- Make sure that any allegations or suspicions of abuse, discrimination or harassment are recorded and acted upon as appropriate.
- Respect confidentiality processes when sharing information about young people.
