Narrative Program

7+ Years

The Narrative program is aimed at assisting children who need help to write or tell stories at school. Narrative work is useful for children learning to sequence, learning the parts of telling a story, and learning to tell a fully developed story.

The work in the narrative program can entail listening to stories and answering questions or retelling a story or developing your own stories. This is a critical skill in school. Some of the programs we use include: Story Building, Story Grammar Therapy, Story Champs, SKILLS Program (Supporting Knowledge in Language and Literacy).

RUNS AS

Small groups of 2 to 4 children matched by age. May be individually run.

REQUIREMENTS

For this program we need to ensure the child has adequate listening, memory, and language skills and some testing may need to be done. We often use the Test of Narrative Language to determine if a child is needing this program.

Speech-Language Interventionists.
