

# **4WD Vehicle Checklist**

# **Variety Victoria Motoring Events**

#### 1. 4WD Vehicles

- i. **4WD Vehicles:** can be of any age. They must have a four wheel drive system.
- ii. **Refusal of Entry:** Variety the Children's Charity of Victoria reserves the right to refuse the entry of a vehicle.
- iii. Vehicle Registration: Vehicles must have current road registration.

#### 2. 4WD Vehicle Insurance

- i. It is compulsory for all Variety 4WD Vehicles to have a minimum of third party insurance.
- ii. Ensure that your vehicle is insured for use on 'non-gazetted roads',
- iii. **Famous Specialist Car Insurance:** Famous Insurance Agency provides standard motor vehicle coverage tailored to suit the vehicles used by participants of the Variety Motoring events. In addition, they also support Variety, so we strongly encourage you to insure your cars with Famous Insurance.

#### 3. Mobile Workshop Day

- i. All Variety 4WD vehicles must attend the Workshop Day arranged by Variety to allow a mechanic to check your vehicle to ensure that it meets the Variety 4WD Vehicle Compliance criteria. This requirement does not affect your obligation to ensure that your Variety 4WD vehicle is in a safe and roadworthy condition, as required by law.
- ii. Vehicles need to match or exceed the standards set in this document by the Mobile Workshop Day.
- iii. Bookings are essential, the dates, times and locations will be advised by Variety Victoria. If a vehicle does not meet the compliance criteria it will not be allowed to begin the event.
- iv. Vehicle / Driver Paperwork checked at Mobile Workshop Weekend:
  - Proof of Registration
  - Proof of Insurance
  - Copies of Drivers Licenses for all crew members



# 4. 4WD Vehicle Requirements

# **Mechanical Modifications**

Туре	Status	Notes	
Brakes	Compulsory	Brake lines should be protected by hose.	
	Compulsory	Excessive exhaust noise will not be permitted.	
Exhaust	Advice	Extractors and a sports exhaust system may be fitted, but an effective silencer may be used.	
Fuel Storage	Compulsory	Fuel may be carried in jerry cans. Jerry cans must be compliant with AS/NZS 2906:2001 standards. Jerry cans must be stored outside of the passenger vehicle and must be secured.	
Fuel Range	Compulsory	4WD vehicles must have sufficient fuel onboard (tank & jerry cans) for a travel range of five hundred and fifty (550) kilometres of travel	



# **Interior Modifications**

Туре	Status	Notes	
Cargo Barriers	Compulsory*	It is compulsory to have cargo barriers fitted to all station wagons and be compliant with safety standard AS/NZS 4034:2001.	
Fire Extinguisher	Compulsory	At a minimum, a 1kg fire extinguisher needs to be carried at all times.	
Tripmeters	Compulsory	At a minimum, it is required that each vehicle has an operational tripmeter in their vehicle. We recommend fitting either a <b>rally tripmeter</b> or using a <b>tripmeter smartphone app</b> in your car.	
Radio (UHF)	Compulsory	All vehicles must be fitted with an operating 40 or 80 channel UHF radio.	
Seat Belts	Compulsory	All vehicles must have seat belts for all passengers. The belts should be a minimum of a 3 point (lap/sash) seatbelt.	



# **Exterior Modifications**

Туре	Status	Notes	
Amber Dust Light	Compulsory	An Amber flashing light must be fitted to the rear of the car as high as possible. This is for safety when driving in dusty conditions.  Red or Blue flashing lights are illegal to use under VicRoads Regulations (as they are reserved for emergency vehicles) and are banned for this event.	
Mud Flaps	Compulsory	Mud flaps must be fitted for all wheels on the vehicle.	
Number and ID Panels	Compulsory	All 4WD vehicle identification numbers and door panels are supplied by Variety and will be available for collection at Mobile Workshop Weekend.  Door Panels: Affixed to the two front doors. Black numbers displayed in space provided on the number panel.  Front Car ID: Affixed to front windscreen, top left.  Rear Car ID: Affixed to rear windscreen, top right.	
Smoke Emitting	Advice	Entrants are permitted to fit water based fog machines to their vehicles	
Devices	Compulsory	These devices may only be used when stationary (i.e. not be used when mobile)	
Sponsor Stickers	Compulsory	Official sponsors' decals/stickers will be provided by the Variety Office at the Workshop Day and must be displayed on each Variety 4WD vehicle as per the sponsorship agreement in place.	
Wheels & Tyres	Compulsory  Advice  Compulsory	A car must have a spare.  Original wheel size can be upgraded in order to upgrade to larger tyres.  All-Terrain tyres are mandatory
