A Wagon for Oliver & Riley

"Once my twins had outgrown a pram, life got a bit tricky. With their health issues and complex needs, we started to become a little bit house bound, especially once their younger brother came along.

To leave the house for anything more than a kinder drop off had become too much. My twins both have level 2 ASD and don't cope too well in situations such as shopping centres, markets and events. Not only that, my son who has epilepsy can tire quite quickly, which ultimately can cause a seizure. My children were a risk to their own safety, and I lost confidence in my ability to keep them safe when I was alone with them, which was most of the time. Since receiving the wagon, we no longer have to miss out. We've conquered zoo trips, shopping centres, walks, doctors' trips, hospital clinic days and all sorts ON MY OWN! It has changed our lives. I have my independence back. I no longer have to worry about keeping them all safe, the ability to strap them all in and know where they are is such a relief. And they love it too! They're always begging to get into the wagon, it's their safe space.

I will be forever grateful for the huge impact that this Wonderfold W4 LUXE Quad Wagon has had on our lives."

A Wheelchair for Layla-Grace

Layla-Grace is a courageous and spirited 6-year-old who loves the outdoors and visiting new places. Layla-Grace is living with Cerebral Palsy and her old stroller was falling short in meeting her postural and mobility needs, hindering her from fully experiencing the joy of school excursions and community outings. This year Variety granted Layla-Grace a Zippie X-cape manual wheelchair! This wheelchair was carefully selected to provide Layla with the freedom and independence she deserves and needs to thrive. Now Layla-Grace can confidently traverse longer distances, socially interact with her peers and greatly improve her ability to explore and learn new skills.

This contribution will not only improve Layla-Grace's physical well-being but also enhance her social interactions and overall quality of life.

A Genie Bed for Charlotte

The 2023 Variety Bash made a special stop in regional Victoria to present Charlotte with a life-changing grant, a Medifab Genie Bed, tailored to meet her unique needs.

Charlotte is a fun and vibrant little girl who loves nothing more than playing with her friends and spending time with family.

Charlotte was diagnosed with the rare Wolf-Hirschhorn Syndrome, a rare genetic condition affecting just 1 in 50,000 individuals. This results in various challenges including global developmental delay, seizures, physical and intellectual disabilities, non-verbal communication, and feeding through a PEG tube.

Charlotte faced a severe health crisis last year, contracting Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) twice, requiring a bipap machine every night for breathing support. The Medifab Genie Bed is designed specifically for Charlotte, ensuring her safety and comfort, especially during respiratory infections. It provides peace of mind to her family, knowing she has a safe sleeping environment.

Variety Sunshine Coaches

Variety Sunshine Coaches play a vital role in our mission to support children with physical disabilities, regional limitations, or social disadvantages. In a recent CYDA survey, it was reported that 70% of children with a disability are excluded from events and activities^{*}.

Our coaches provide much-needed transport to allow children to connect with their communities, engage in programs, and enjoy various activities that they might not have access to otherwise. What's even more remarkable is that these coaches can be equipped with wheelchair modifications, ensuring that all children can participate in excursions and extra-curricular activities together, promoting inclusivity and creating memorable experiences.

In this financial year, Variety - the Children's Charity of Victoria has continued to make a difference by presenting three Variety Sunshine Coaches across Victoria: Latrobe Special Developmental School in Traralgon, Hamlyn Views School in Geelong, and Skene Street Specialist School in Stawell.

Each coach represents an opportunity to change lives, bringing smiles and hope to children facing unique challenges. These coaches open doors to brighter futures, and the impact they have on young lives is truly immeasurable.

28 scholarships were granted this year! We are proud to share where some of our past and present Variety Heart Scholarship recipients are on their journeys - here are some of their remarkable achievements.

Andrew Dinh

Variety Heart Scholar, Andrew, has been making waves in the swimming world with a series of outstanding achievements this year. At the Victorian Age LC Championships, his talent shone brightly as he claimed a remarkable 9 Bronze medals and achieved personal bests in all 9 of his races! His stellar performance continued on the Gold Coast, where he proudly represented the Otters and secured 6 personal bests out of 8 events across 7 MultiClass competitions. Andrew's unwavering commitment and relentless training paid off, earning his club a remarkable 44 points!

Demonstrating his exceptional skills, Andrew dominated the Special Olympics Inter-Regional Aquatic Games, securing gold medals in all of his individual events. In a remarkable feat, he even outperformed one of the fastest and strongest swimmers by an impressive 2 seconds in the 200m Individual Medley!

Sonny Rennison

11-year-old Sonny is a rising tennis star, currently 26 in the world in the Juniors Singles Ranking for Wheelchair Tennis!

Sonny has Multiple Epiphyseal Dysplasia (MED) - a genetic bone condition - and uses a wheelchair for mobility and sport. Sonny is a current Variety Heart Scholarship recipient and has achieved some incredible results this year.

Sonny competed in the ITF Melbourne Classic Wheelchair Tennis tournament, where he won his first singles match and, with his doubles partner, won the Junior Doubles competition. The Greg Crump Teams Cup at Melbourne Park was another highlight, where he and his doubles partner won all but one of their matches, and Sonny won two of his singles matches.

In November, Sonny won his first singles title in the U/14 Junior Singles category at the Australian Wheelchair Tennis National Championships, as well as first place in the Open Junior Doubles category. We are so proud of Sonny's achievements!

Jack Howell

Jack was awarded Variety Heart Scholarships in 2019 -2022. During this time we saw him succeed and become an inspiration to other kids. In 2023 we welcomed Jack as a Variety Ambassador and have loved watching him keep raising the bar and excelling in his triathlon career!

This year Jack claimed the silver medal for Australia at the prestigious World Triathlon Para Series in Japan, 4th place in Swansea and 6th place in Spain. His outstanding achievements have catapulted Jack to 5th position in the World Rankings, and what's even more astonishing is that this is Jack's first year of racing internationally!

The Paralympic qualifying period runs until 30 June, 2024. Athletes will accumulate points based on their top three race positions. Congratulations and best of luck Jack!

One of his most notable accomplishments was representing his country at the Paralympic Games in September 2016, where he made his debut in the men's long jump T20 category, securing an impressive fifth place. At the Tokyo 2020 Paralympics, Nick's talent shone even brighter as he clinched the bronze medal in the same category with a distance of 7.12m. Nick is currently working towards the 2024 Paralympics in Paris.

How We Help

Kids' Programs

Variety SHINE Program

The Variety SHINE Program is dedicated to addressing the educational hurdles faced by students who grapple with learning challenges, often lagging behind their peers across multiple academic domains.

The program provides students with access to a specialised team of onsite allied health professionals within their school environment. These professionals are from diverse disciplines and collaborate to conduct comprehensive assessments of each child, gaining insights into their individual needs and crafting personalised support strategies.

The primary objectives of the Variety SHINE Program are threefold:

- Deliver speech, language, literacy, and social skills support to children with Developmental Learning Disabilities (DLDs) within a conventional school setting.
- 2. Enhance and support the school environment and teaching staff, equipping them to better manage the unique challenges presented by students with DLDs.
- 3. Provide training and mentorship opportunities for university students in clinical placements.

The overarching goal is to provide children with DLDs, the intensive intervention they require within a familiar school context, fostering improvement in their areas of challenge and enabling them to keep pace with their peers in both learning and social development. Students leave the program with a cohesive plan, offering recommendations applicable in both home and classroom settings, with the aim of enhancing the child's long-term learning outcomes.

This collaborative effort helps to alleviate financial burdens on families and addresses challenges arising from separate practitioners lacking a comprehensive understanding of a child's multifaceted issues. The program's framework empowers health professionals to strategise effectively, providing robust recommendations that enable families and teachers to continue to address complex needs across various disciplines.



Variety Abilities Unleashed - Kids

This year, we embarked on an exciting journey with Disability Sports Australia, launching Variety Abilities Unleashed – Kids program in Victoria!

This program offers a free, enjoyable, and inclusive sports experience, tailored for children with physical disabilities, or facing social challenges from metro and regional areas.

Variety Rally Around Victoria

3-6 March 2023

Rally Around Victoria returned for its second year, embarking on a curated 3-day drive around Victoria that began at the Fox Museum in Melbourne and concluded at Pizzini Winery in Whitfield. Along the way, participants dined outdoors at the Central Deborah Gold Mine in Bendigo as well as the Halls Gap Zoo, where animals came to visit during the evening!

True to the spirit of Variety motoring events, grant presentations marked key stops along the route. Our initial presentation was at Coonara Community House, where we presented funding for computer lab equipment designed to support Autistic youth aged 10-16 years with gaming, coding, and programming skills. This was followed by a grant stop at Rochester Primary and Secondary schools to present gifts and educational resources to support the schools after last year's devastating floods. Our incredible Rally Around Victoria team even raised an additional \$600 for the students! The final grant stop was Skene Street Specialist School in Stawell, where we announced our granting of a Variety Sunshine Coach to the school.

Rally Around Victoria achieved an impressive fundraising total of \$125,000 for Victorian children; a success made possible by the dedication of every entrant and the invaluable support of our Gold Heart Sponsor, ACE Radio.





Variety Brats Bash

10-18 April 2023

The Variety Brats Bash kicked off its adventure with 24 cars and 84 entrants, exploring the enchanting landscapes of Australia's outback, the lush hills of South Australia, and the stunning coastlines along the way.

Commencing in Mildura, the event began on a heartwarming note with a Variety Bikes for Kids grant benefiting 10 local children. While the ultimate destination was K'gari (King Fisher Bay), the journey North included some of Australia's most iconic locations, including Wagga Wagga, Bathurst, Tamworth, Glen Innes, Kilcoy, and Noosa North Shore. Each stop revealed breathtaking landscapes, diverse wildlife, and the unique cultures that collectively make Australia such a special place.

Variety Bikes for Kids

One of Variety's most loved programs, Bikes for Kids, has been bringing smiles to children facing disadvantage by providing them with brand-new bikes since 2002. Championed by program founder and Variety Life Member, Derryn Hinch, Bikes for Kids receives steadfast support year-round from our donors and fundraisers, with a special emphasis during tax time.

This year, we were overwhelmed by the generosity of our community which made it possible for us to support 619 kids through the program. Brodie is now 13 and has outgrown his original bike, so through the Variety Bikes for Kids program, a new adaptive bike was granted. The new bike ensures that Brodie can continue to enjoy family outings with his big brother Kye and will allow him the joy of actively participating in activities out of the home. This bike has been a fantastic tool in helping with Brodie's rehabilitation following surgery, and maintaining his physical activity.

You may remember Brodie from a few years back when he received his first adaptive bike from Variety. This special bike had a magic effect that Brodie's family will never forget! Brodie lives with multiple physical challenges and his parents Deanne and Shaun had been told he would never walk. But guess what? He can ride!
